For the Tropical Architecture Summer School 2026, you can choose between different living experiences:

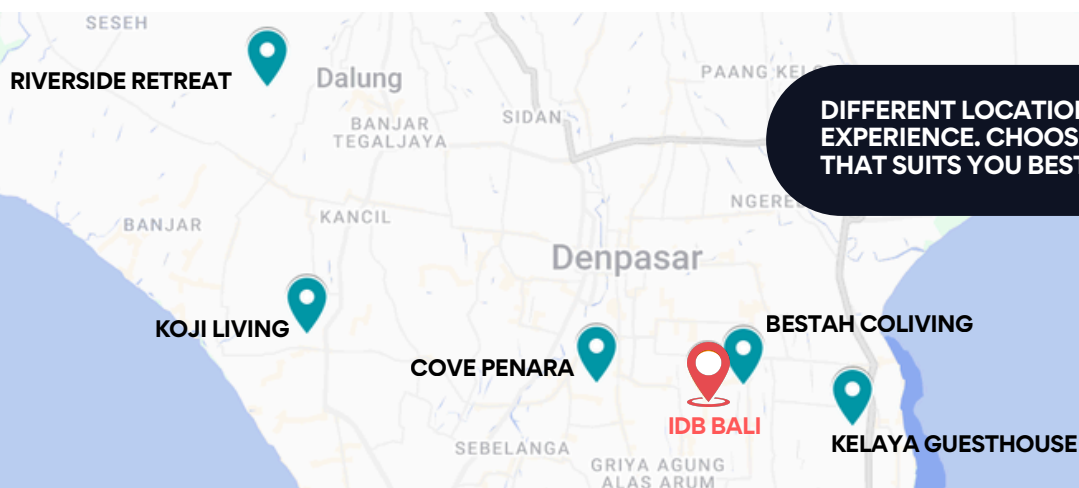
Bestah Co-Living is only a few minutes from campus, right in Denpasar's Renon district. This central location makes it especially convenient for daily classes, with shops, local eateries, and Sanur beach just a short ride away. It's perfect if you prefer quick access to campus and an authentic, practical Bali lifestyle.

Cove Penara is located in central Denpasar, around 10 minutes from IDB Bali Campus. Similar to Bestah Co-Living, it is one of the most practical options if you want to stay close to campus and keep your daily commute short. The area feels more urban than beachside, but Sanur Beach, Seminyak, cafés, restaurants, and nightlife spots are still easy to reach when you want to explore Bali beyond campus.

Koji Living is located in Umalas, between Seminyak and Canggu. It offers a stylish residential setting with easy access to cafés, restaurants, shops, gyms, and Bali's popular west coast lifestyle. It's a great choice if you want to be close to Canggu and Seminyak while staying in a well-connected area with plenty happening around you.

Kelaya Guesthouse is located in Sanur, around 15 minutes from IDB Bali Campus by scooter. Sanur is more relaxed than Canggu, with cafés, restaurants, bars, and beachside spots nearby. It's a great choice if you want a calmer home base while still staying close to the beach and within easy reach of campus.

Riverside Retreat is about 40 minutes from campus, located in the popular area of Canggu. The easiest way to get around is by scooter. It's fast, flexible, and gives you the freedom to explore hidden beaches, rice fields, and cafés all around the island. You can rent one for around €50/month. Not into riding? No problem – apps like Gojek (the local Uber) take you anywhere you need to go, quickly and affordably.

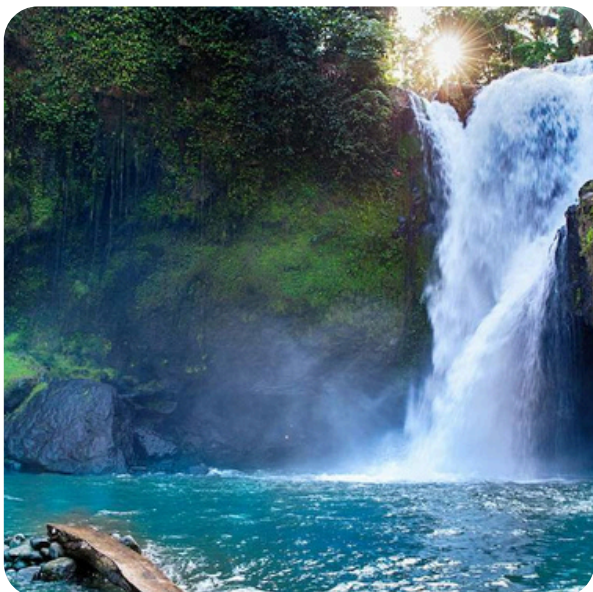


LIVING THE ISLAND LIFE

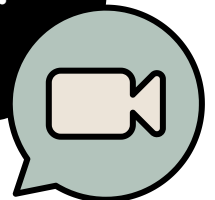
FINAL STEPS

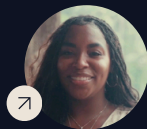

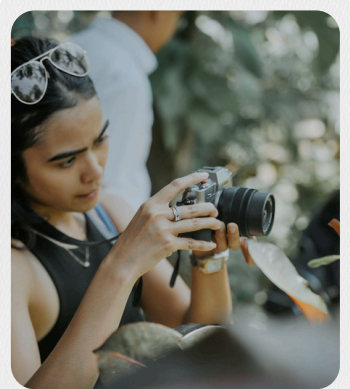
